to the 43rd Synod

#### TODAY, IN OBEDIENCE TO GOD, I PLEDGE:

- I pledge to commit each day to Jesus, to resolve conflicts, to get enough sleep and to invite Jesus to be with me when I wake
- 2) I pledge each day, to speak to Jesus about my anxieties and concerns and to acknowledge my dependence on Jesus
- 3) I pledge to begin each working day with Jesus: to show up on time, to greet coworkers, to take a moment to pray, and to spend moments with God during my breaks
- 4) I pledge to speak words of love to others, to use touch, to look for simple acts of service, to learn from difficult people, and to be open to feedback
- 5) I pledge to listen for god's leadings each day and to follow them
- 6) I pledge each day to schedule a time to be alone with God in quiet solitude
- 7) I pledge to use my spiritual pathways to connect with and stay connected with God
- 8) I pledge to heal myself of hurry-sickness
