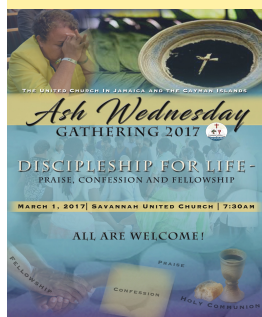


Ash Wednesday Events!
