Reflections from the RDGS

At the threshold of this New Year, we are invited to pause for reflection. In Lamentations 3:22-23, we read 'Because of the LORD's great love we are not consumed, for His compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is Your faithfulness.' This pericope reminds us in a very profound way of God's faithfulness and mercy and that we can depend on God daily and also in the direst of situations. We have much to give God thanks for as in many ways God remained faithful to us during 2017. As a nation we were spared any damage from one of the costliest Hurricane Seasons, we had General Elections that were free from fear, the economy has remained fairly stable and the pillars of the economy are secured.

Ms. Renita Barnes, our Marketing, Communications and Events Coordinator participated successfully as the UCJCI participant in the Council for World Mission (CWM) Training in Mission Programme (TIM). Renovations were completed at of the Gun Bay Sanctuary and it was rededicated on 3rd December, 2017. The Woodlawn Duplex and the Beach Bay land were transferred to Council and we now have these resources at our disposal. We give thanks to God for the generosity of the benefactors.

In 2018 we are encouraged to praying earnestly for our ministry to youth and young adult, for our overall growth- numerically and spiritually, for the level of our commitment and for our willingness to serve. In response to some aspects of our concerns, Ms. Barnes has been appointed as the Programme Secretary for Children, Youth and Young Adults. The RDGS has taken on the portfolio for the Women and Men's Ministry.

Reflections from the RDGS contd.

The hope is that with support from the Council Staff, these ministries in Council will experience further growth and development. By April 2018, the CIRMC will register as a Non- Profit Organisation under the Non- Profit Organisation Law of the Cayman Islands. This will bring some changes to our financial reporting and Congregations are being asked to adhere to the new rules and requirements.

In 2018, Convocations will be held on April 15 (Jamaica) and April 22(Cayman Islands). The theme is 'Disciples of Peace' and we will in Congregations and the communities demonstrate our commitment to peace.

In this Synodical period, the UCJCI will follow the strategic missional direction which encompasses:

- Children and Youth Ministries,
- Adult and Family Life Ministries
- Public Witness and Advocacy
- Church in Ministry



During 2018, in each quarter there will be the following emphasis: January- March:

'The Word' (Church in Ministry) **April - June:** 'Adult and Family Life' **July- September:** 'Children and Youth' **October - December:** 'Advocacy' Council and Congregations will also follow this strategic direction and develop ministry goals and plans according to the Synodical guidelines.

We have entered this year with great expectation

and we are trusting in the faithful God for guidance, wisdom and mercy. With certainty we will proclaim 'great is thy faithfulness' as we continue to pray and serve God together.

LEARN ABOUT THE LITURGICAL SEASON: THE SEASON OF EPIPHANY - The season of Epiphany is from January 6 to February 13, 2018. Epiphany celebrates the incarnation of Christ and the manifestation or theophany - the revelation of God to the world in Jesus Christ. The word Epiphany is from Koine Greek ἐπιφάνεια, *epiphaneia*, meaning manifestation or appearance. It is derived from a verb meaning "to appear." In classical Greek it was used of the appearance of dawn, of an enemy in war, but especially of a manifestation of a deity to a worshiper (a theophany). In the New Testament the word is used in 2 Timothy 1:10 to refer either to the birth of Christ or to his appearance after his resurrection, and five times to refer to his Second Coming.
